Please use separate entry form for each dog. NFC to be at the organiser's discretion. Dogs may **only** run in one class in the morning.

Entries close on 14 March 2020 when the draw will be made.

Definition: Novice Dog/Novice Handler – Neither dog nor handler to have won ANY award or COM at a working test or field trial, run under KC rules, other than Puppy/Special Puppy or ND/NH (1st would eliminate). **Novice** - for dogs that have not gained an award or COM at a field trial, been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Working Test or 1st at a Novice Working Test held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.

Awards – The Windyhollows Bounty Memorial Trophy for novice winner; the Monica Woods Memorial Trophy for novice runner up; Vortex Cup for judges' choice; Pallingforth Trophy for open winner; Yonsaff Cup for open runner up. All to be held for one year. Cards and mementos to 4th place in both classes.
